

## 22 APR 2018 AFCC ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES

**ATTENDEES:** There was a quorum.

### **MEETING REPORTS:**

## 1. Opening:

The AFCC 2017 Annual Meeting opened at the Museum at 1600 hrs with the Pledge of Allegiance led by AFCC President, LTC Larry DiNardo.

## 2. <u>Secretary's Report:</u>

COL(MA) Saluti presented the 22 OCT 2017 AFCC Semi-Annual Meeting minutes, which were unanimously approved.

### 3. <u>Treasurer's Report:</u>

Association Treasurer, CW3 Stedman, reported that there was approximately \$15.5K in the Operating Account, and that all bills were paid. There is approximately \$8.9K in the Restricted Funds Accounts. There are no outstanding loans. The Treasurer's Report was unanimously approved.

#### 4. Finance Committee:

Richard DeVito gave a Finance Committee update. He was accompanied by Gary Coon, from Finer Wealth Management, who gave a presentation on the AFCC investment mix. Gary Coon stated that the AFCC will continue to have domestic investments as the majority of its holdings. He stated that the AFCC had a 12.23% return in 2017. Richard DeVito stated that currently, holdings in the Investment Account are valued at \$558.6K. The Craig Brown Funds Account is valued at \$865K. Total holdings are valued at \$1,423,686.57. The Finance Committee will continue to work with Finer Wealth Management on a regular basis in order to monitor investment performance. The Finance Committee's Report was unanimously approved.

# 5. Membership:

MAJ Cunningham gave the Membership Report. The status of life and regular members was presented. 19 new members were presented, and it was noted that there are 6 applications from today's New Member Welcome event. The AFCC membership is up 25 for this year.

#### 6. Website:

COL Matlak and Michelle Abrams gave a comprehensive Website Report and demonstrated the new website.

# 7. <u>Collections Committee/Museum Report:</u>

COL Wood, MAJ Pillai, and Michelle Abrams gave a detailed presentation on the status of the Museum's collections.

### 8. House Report:

John O'Brien gave the House Report. He discussed various maintenance updates and the upcoming pointing project.

### 9. Prudential Committee:

COL(MA) Silva, Prudential Committee Chairman, gave no formal report. However, he made it clear that the Prudential Committee had voted to approve a pointing project.

#### 10. Active Unit Report:

LTC Cipro presented the Active Unit Report. A variety of topics was discussed: Active Unit partnerships with other agencies; preliminary AT plans; law enforcement kits; retention programs; Command visits; and the status of Unit deployment..

### 11. Events:

COL(MA) Saluti reported on events. He discussed Memorial Day, June Day, the Golf Tournament, the Greatest Generation event, and the AFCC Christmas Party.

### 12. President's Report:

LTC DiNardo gave his outgoing President's Report. He thanked the BOD and the membership for their support. He discussed all the major accomplishments during his Presidency.

# 13. Nominating Committee Report/Election of Officers/Turnover of the Gavel:

COL Richard Matlak, Chairman of the Nominating Committee, presented the slate of Officers, Directors, and Committee Members for 2018-2020. An election was conducted to include a request for nominations from the floor. There were no nominations from the floor, and the slate was unanimously elected. LTC DiNardo turned over the gavel to incoming President, Gus Niewenhous.

#### 14. Old Business/New Business:

The past Presidents in attendance placed the gorget upon the incoming President and awarded the outgoing President with a Paul Revere pitcher.

### 15. Incoming President's Closing of the Meeting:

The 2018 Annual Meeting was adjourned at 1800 hrs by President Gus Niewenhous.
